Location: India is located in the southern part of the continent of **Asia**.

Size: It is the **7th largest** country in the world by area and the most populous.

Neighbors: Our neighbors include Pakistan, China, Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh, Myanmar, and Sri Lanka.

Boundaries: It is bounded by the **Himalayas** in the north, the **Arabian Sea** in the west, the **Bay of Bengal** in the east, and the **Indian Ocean** in the south.

Political Divisions: India is divided into **28 States** and **8 Union Territories** for better administration. New Delhi is the capital.

Physical Features: India has diverse landforms: The Northern Mountains, Northern Plains, Great Indian Desert, Southern Plateau, and Coastal Plains & Islands.
